We're very excited to announce the arrival of Bordentown City's first ever organic Community Garden is here! Our Community Garden is already underway in the open lot in between East Union Street and East Burlington Street behind the Mt. Zion Church, next to the baseball field.

Plots are now available to purchase! Here are all the details:

- **Plot Size:** Each plot is 6 ft. x 10 ft. or 60 sq. ft.
- **Plot Cost:** Cost for 1 plot is \$25 (*Note you can purchase multiple plots*)
- **Availability:** Garden plots will be distributed based on a lottery drawing of interested people. If you are not chosen in the drawing, we will put you on a wait list to be notified when a plot becomes available.
- **Growing Season:** May 2015 thru October 2015
- **Deadline:** You'll need to reserve your plot by Friday, May 1st

The \$25 plot fee is a one-time fee that pays for common expenses including maintenance and water. Gardeners provide their own tools, plants, seeds, soil amendments, and any other supplies. Organic gardening practices are preferred.
